

What is Family Violence? • What is family violence? Is it all
right to assume that if a man does not beat his wife there is no
violence in the home? What about spanking children? When a
two year old runs across a busy street and gets a swat on the
bottom as a result. Is that considered an act of violence?
-In the Handbook for the Prevention of Family Violence, family
violence is defined as. . . "any act of commission or commission
by family members, and any conditions resulting from such acts
or inaction, which deprive other family members of equal rights
and liberties and/or interfere with their optimal development and
freedom of choice." • Simply stated, family violence is an abuse
of power. Those persons who are bigger, stronger or have greater
access to valued resources impose their wills on others who are
smaller, weaker or without resource. Some facts to think about:
• it is estimated that one quarter of all children are abused before
they turn sixteen. • one in eight Canadian women is a victim of
wife assault or dating violence. • one in five murders in Canada
is a result of domestic violence. Eighty-five percent of them are
by men against women. • The extent of elder abuse is not
known. It is estimated that from half a million to 2.5 million
elderly people each year may be the victims of different kinds of
moderate to severe domestic abuse. • more violent crimes occur in the
home than outside it's doors, and more violence occurs between family
members than among strangers. • professionals and workers in the field of
family violence are just now discovering the extent of the problem and
it's effect on society. They are quickly frustrated by the fact that there
are no easy answers. However, awareness is the first step to change.
The series of articles by the Safe Shelter co-ordinators in this newspaper
