Police Report

-Hunting from the highway. -On 96NOV11 at 08:30hrs. police were called to the West Twin area of Hwy. 16 as two males were suspected of shooting a deer near the Highway. Police located the Surrey residents near the Goat River Rd. One male had his rifle, ammunition and mule deer seized. Charges from the Conservation Officer are pending. Hunters are reminded that no hunting is permitted within 400 meters of Hwy 16. -Accident. On 96NOV13 at 1703hrs. police, ambulance, and the rescue truck were called out to a single vehicle roll over accident west of the West Twin Creek. The vehicle lost control in a snow storm and ended up upside down in two feet of water. An adult female is in serious condition in Prince George Hospital as a result.

-Lost Snowmobilers. On 96NOV15 at 21:30hrs. police were advised that two Prince George snowmobilers were lost on Bell Mountain. The third member of the group was able to direct the Robson Valley Search and Rescue to the right area and the missing people were located near midnight. Unfortunately, due to their location, the searchers were only able to signal the missing men. A helicopter was hired in the morning to rescue the pair who had built a fire to help them survive the night. -Impaired Driver. -On 96NOV15 at 21:45hrs. police stopped an erratic driver on Hwy 16 near McBride. The driver was found to be impaired and was detained for the purpose of providing breath samples into the Breathalyzer. As a result a 37 year old McBride resident has been charged with impaired driving while over .08.
