What Do You Know About Suicide? -Submitted by Lionel Gendreau
- Some people have referred to suicide as the ultimate expression of individual choice, others believe it to be the regrettable waste of a most precious gift. Whatever opinion you have formed of suicide, statistics indicate that it will touch all of our lives, either directly or indirectly. When it does how will you deal with it? - Would you be able to recognize the signs and symptoms of a loved one contemplating suicide? How should you respond if someone told you that they wanted to kill themselves? Will talking about suicide with a person at risk make them more likely to act upon their intentions? What resources are available in the Robson Valley for a person at risk, or a grieving family? - All these questions, and many more can be answered by attending a two day workshop sponsored by Direct Care Training of Prince George. The workshop was developed by Living Works Education Inc. with the intent of providing individuals with enough skills and information to save someone's life, similar to the aim of C.P.R. and first aid courses. More than 80,000 people world-wide have taken this workshop to date. The workshop will take place in Valemount November 14th and 15th 1996, and is opened to all interested persons. Professional and nonprofessional individuals are encouraged to attend and acquire this life saving skill.
