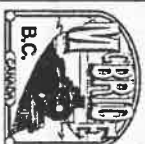

Local News

-The Swinging Bovines are a professional saxophone ensemble based in Calgary, Alberta. Since their formation in Halifax Nova Scotia in July 1991. The Swinging Bovines have emerged as one of Western Canada's premier performing ensembles. The groups members are Gerry Hebert - soprano, Nikki Imbach - alto, Mark Dejong - tenor and Keith Krushel - baritone.
