Hey McBride, started your Spring Cleaning Yet- Well here's a great idea to keep in mind for those clothes you don't want any more. You can take them to the Dorcas Center (now known as Adventist Community Services). Dorcas gets it's name from a women in the Bible, who cared for others and sewed and mended clothing for those in need. You can read about her in Acts 9:36-43. -Today the Dorcas Society is a non-profit organization run by the Seventh Day Adventist Church. Donations of clean used clothing are gladly accepted and then given free of charge to any who may need it or simply would like to take part in the recycling of clothing. (Broom thinks it's a great idea.) -Clothing which is not used here is sent to "ADRA" (the Adventist Disaster & Relief Agency), where it is then sent all over the world. Some may even stay in our own country. ADRA sent clothing, as well as food and shelter, to Montreal last summer when they had severe flooding. Last year Dorcas sent over 300 large cartons of clothing to ADRA. Some of our clothing is also sent to the Salvation Army in Prince George. Rags and quilts are made from unusable clothing and sold. Money carned goes towards operating costs (which are very low), assisting fire victims, in the making of food hampers and also to community projects. Dorcas is open to the community Tuesday afternoons from 1:00p.m. to 3:00p.m. and is located in the S.D.A. Church basement on Lamming Pit Road. If you would like to do some volunteer work, we meet Tuesday mornings at 8:30a.m. to sort clothing, pack ADRA boxes and make rags. We are looking to expand our hours to include an evening during the week, so we can better serve the community. If you would like to see us have evening hours, call Julie at 569-3186.




