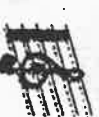

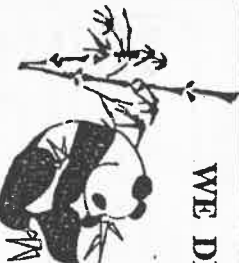

Police Report

FATAL MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT- On Feb. 26, 1997 at approx.. 3:15am a 1989 Ford Escort with five occupants was travelling east bound on Highway 16 approaching the Dome Creek bridge, which is 82kms west of McBride B.C. Heading West bound was a 1995 Western Star logging truck which was loaded and being driven by a 42 year old Prince George man. On a curved portion of the highway, just west of the bridge, in the west bound lane the vehicles collided. Impact to the logging truck was on the front, while the impact to the car was to the drivers side. It was snowing at the time and the road surface had a fresh covering of snow, about 1 cm in depth. -On impact, the car went under the tractor and disintegrated as it was being dragged 140 meters from the point of impact, and came to rest off the roadway on the south side. At this point the car was in pieces and the five bodies were scattered around the scene. -Due to the poor condition of the bodies, confirmation of the identity of the victims will take some time. At this time the victims are believed to be: 1) Dennis Joseph GEIZER age 24 years. from Prince George, B.C. He is the owner of the car. 2) David Jason MARSHELL, age 22 years, from Prince George, B.C. 3) Shane Edward MAZUR, age 20 years, from Prince George, B.C. 4) Derrick Dias BARATIA, age 19 years, from Prince George, B.C. 5) Correlia Britt DAHL, age 18 years from Prince George, B.C. -The identity of the driver of the car is not known at this time. The cause of the accident is still under investigation. Alcohol has not been ruled out and police are waiting for the results of the toxicology tests to clarify this issue. -The R.C.M.P. and the B.C. Coroners service are continuing the investigation into this tragic accident.

This was a shock that came to most people that this could have happened near our town, but now it has and sorry to say probably will happen again. This is the opportunity to look at this very sad event and hope that you will take caution on these roads. We all give our hearts to these poor families in this huge lost. Broom.

POLICE CHASE- On the early morning of 9/FEB/93 the McBride R.C.M.P. entered into a vehicle chase on 1st Ave. in McBride. The accused was later apprehended and now faces charges of Impaired & Refusal, Caused Police pursuit, and Driving without due care and attention.
