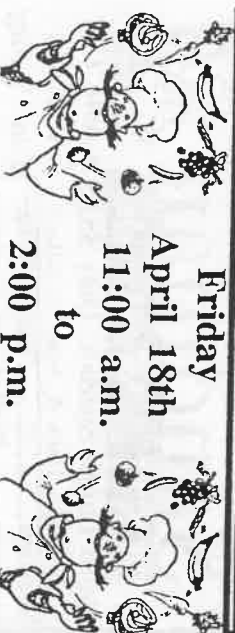

## Police Report
