All right McBride, I missed Murray McLachlan and was very disappointed but I did catch the very funny and talented Lorne Elliott. There where a lot of people there that laughed the whole way through the show, I recommend him to anyone, he was great. Now Roundhouse has changed pace a bit with a Quartet that sounds fabulous. STREETNIX was formed in the fall of 1991 by six students at the University of Saskatchewan - Ward Arnold, Xylon Cozens, Aaron Gense, B.J. Harris, Tony Hughes and Rich Sinclair. In 1992 Xylon Cozens & Rich Sinclair went separate ways from the band. After holding series of auditions, Dave Young, formerly of Calgary, Alberta, joined the group in March of '93. In December of 1993 Streetnix had its first full-length CD - Listen. To Date the album has sold over 12,000 copies nationwide, and continues to sell exceptionally well, making the members of Streetnix Saskatchewan's top-selling independent recording artists. Then in 1994 Ward Arnold left the band to pursue in a career in Civil Engineering, then came along Trent Frank. After doing a great amount of touring to schools and being on the road in 1995, the group decided in June to travel to Edmonton, Alberta, to record it's second album with Ian Armstrong, they had met earlier that year. Streetnix second album, 'Time Permitting', on December of that year. In a little over five months the album had sold over 4,000 copies, and, like the first album, continues to sell very well to this day. Now they are on the road again and Roundhouse is giving you a chance to see this remarkable band on May 14th at 8:00p.m. Tickets are \$12.00 for adults and \$8.00 for students. (It's going to make a great Mother Day's gift)


