Before long, he landed a job leading a house band with the Holiday Inn chain, which, with a stroke of fate, took him to Toronto in 1968. In the fertile jazz mecca of Toronto, Bernie quickly established himself as an accompanist, playing for and with a great variety of visiting musicians. This sounds like a fantastic show to see, so don't miss out.

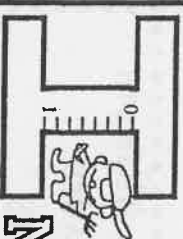
