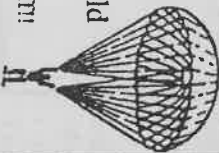

McBride RCMP had received 18 calls for service from the public in the past week.
On 97-08-13 McBride RCMP responded to two separate complaints whereas concerned citizens believed that they may have seen the Kilmat Murderer, Kevin Vermette. The first complainant believed that the suspect may have been hitchhiking towards McBride. A roadblock was set up and an individual resembling the suspect was stopped and questioned. It turned out that the individual has some similarities to the murderer but was not him. The second incident occurred later that evening when Police received a report of an individual travelling between an Eastbound railway car. The train was stopped and searched at Croyden but the individual was not found. The complainant in the second instance did not realize that Police had already located the hitchhiker previously that day.

On 97-08-15 McBride RCMP attended to a complaint of Hit and Run. A parked vehicle in front of the Panda Restaurant was struck and the suspect vehicle was seen driving away. The suspect vehicle was later found and the investigation is continuing.
