Your Baby

Infant Development Program: When your baby needs extra help - What Is The Infant Development Program? -If you are concerned about your baby's development, the Infant Development Program may be able to help you learn how to encourage his or her progress. -This program is funded by the Ministry of Social Services, and is sponsored by non-profit societies in a number of communities throughout the province. Parents and professionals involved in the program believe that the early years of a child's life are very important. Future physical, social and intellectual development depends in part on your baby's early experiences with his or her family. -Usually, a baby from birth to three years develops at a rapid pace. Some babies, however, are slow to reach developmental milestones such as sitting unsupported, playing with toys, walking and talking. With extra help from you and your family, and perhaps a different approach in teaching skills, your baby can be encouraged to learn and may progress more readily. -Infant Development Consultants are professionals trained to assist you with concerns about your baby. A consultant will visit you on a regular basis in your home and work with you to develop a program of activities for your baby. Using these suggestions, and your knowledge of your baby, you can plan activities to encourage the development of physical, social and intellectual skills. Special toys, equipment, and books on child development are available through the program. If your baby has a disability, you can get up-to-date information on that disability. Materials are also available in languages other than English. -You will have opportunities to meet other parents, individually, through parent meetings or relevant workshops. Most Infant Development Programs also offer playgroups for parents and children. Consultants can also refer you to other community resources, to help you meet your baby's needs. -Community professionals involved with the Infant Development Program include: •Public health nurse; •Doctor; •Preschool teacher; •Physiotherapist; •Social workers; •Speech and language pathologist; •and others. -HOW CAN MY FAMILY TAKE PART IN THE INFANT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM?- Referrals to the Infant Development Program may come from any source - parent, doctor, community health nurse, etc... Children aged birth to five years, who are delayed in one or more skill area, are eligible for this program.
