On Saturday, October 4th, the Canadian Associates of Chiefs of Police will sponsor Operation Impact, a Canada-wide traffic law enforcement and education initiative. Police officers from the OPP, RCMP, Surete du Quebec, along with municipal and regional police services will join across Canada to focus their attention on the "High Risk Driver". Research has shown that the "High Risk Driver" persistently engages in a range of behaviours such as impaired driving, non use of seat belts and excessive speeding. Operation Impact will target this type of driver in order to make Canada's roads the safest in the world. The goal of this 24 hour campaign is to reduce the deaths and injuries on our highways through traffic enforcement and road safety education. In 1996, officers from 216 Canadian Police Services stopped more than 298,700 vehicles, issued 9,014 seat belt charges and 9,514 other traffic-related charges including 500 for impaired driving. 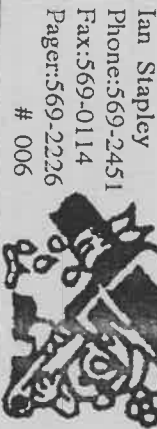
