Police Report

Sexual Assault- In the evening of October 3rd police were called to attend a McBride residence. An allegation of sexual assault is being investigated.

-Disturbance- In the early morning hours of October 5th police were called from another McBride residence. An allegation of causing a disturbance and uttering threats was made against two McBride area women. This matter was resolved informally.

-Stray Dogs- On October 6th police received a complaint of stray dogs in the Dyke Road area. Police would like to remind residents that the whole valley excluding the village boundaries is covered by the Livestock Protection Act which requires dog owners to have their dogs under their immediate control at all times, or have them restrained on their property. There have been many incidents where pedestrians and cyclists have been startled or attacked by loose dogs. A little over a year ago a number of sheep had to be put down as a result of a vicious dog attack.

-Disobey Flagman- On October 7th police attended Hwy. 16 near the Goat River area. A driver has disobeyed the flag person for a line painting crew. The driver was issued a \$173.00 violation ticket under Section 141 of the Motor Vehicle Act; Disobey a flag person.

-Car Fire- At 3:25pm. on October 10th the McBride Fire Department and RCMP were called to attend a car fire on Main St. A 1989 ford hatchback had caught fire under the hood and was destroyed. There were no injuries. A faulty wire harness which shorted out is the suspected cause.

-Theft- On October 10th police were called to attend the Elks Hall for a theft complaint. An old power meter was stolen from the back of the building. There are no suspects. Police are seeking assistance from the public to solve this theft.

-Suicidal Person- On October 10th police responded to a suicidal person complaint in McBride. The victim had taken a number of pills and was planning further action. The victim was arrested under the Mental Health Act and transported to the Hospital.

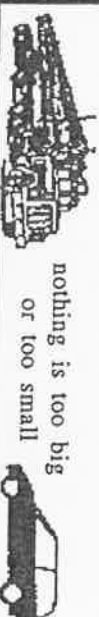
