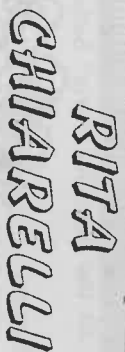

## POLICE REPORT

On April 4th, 1998 at 1:30 a.m. a 3rd Avenue McBride resident was awoken to a rattling of a door. The resident opened the door to find a masked person attempting to get inside. The culprit fled on foot towards Main Street. RCMP Police Dog Handler Cpl. Joe Hape was in the area along with his dog Steele. The dog unsuccessfully located the culprit, but did locate a jacket believed to be worn. The investigation is continuing.

On April 4, 1998, McBride RCMP assisted the B.C. Coroners Service with a death of a local 4 year old child. B.C. Coroners Service is continuing their investigation.

On April 6, 1998, McBride RCMP executed a Criminal Code Search Warrant for stolen property. Police recovered a home stereo system that been stolen in a Break and Enter in February, 1998. The investigation is continuing.

Police also located an indoor growing of Marijuana and subsequently obtained a Search Warrant under the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act. 93 Marijuana plants were seized along with P paraphernalia. A McBride male adult is being charged.

On April 6, 1998, McBride RCMP responded to a motor vehicle incident at 2km west of Snowshoe Creek. A pickup rear-ended a car travelling to Prince George from Saskatchewan when it slowed because of dust created by equipment cleaning the highway. The driver of the pickup could not see the car ahead had slowed because of the dust. 3 occupants of the car, and driver of the pickup were not injured seriously, however, a 17 month old female was taken to McBride hospital for routine observation. The investigation is continuing.

On April 6, 1998 Police responded to a complaint of a loud party in McBride. When police arrived the music was quite loud and two people were located consuming alcohol outside. The incident was resolved without charges.

On April 8, 1998, McBride RCMP responded to a single motor vehicle accident. 3 young persons were transported to hospital by ambulance with minor injuries. The vehicle left the highway near Horsey Creek. The incident is still under investigation.
