Police Report

GAS 'THEFT'- The police were called to a 5th Ave. address in McBride on March 28th in the evening on a report of suspicious youths trespassing. Further inspection revealed that the youths were in the process of stealing some gas from the victims pick up truck. They ran without the gas.

INJURY ACCIDENT- Police were called to the area of the old Dunster bridge on the early morning of March 28th. Two Alberta residents were found wandering in the area of a car which had missed the curve and had become disabled in the field. The two males refused an offer to call an ambulance, and were assisted by a nearby resident with first aid. They were later transported to the hospital by police with non life threatening injuries.

DISTURB THE PEACE- Police were called to a local Inn at 2:30 a.m. on March 29th to deal with a number of noisy hockey players, sledders, and local citizens. No charges were laid.
