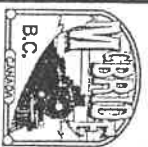

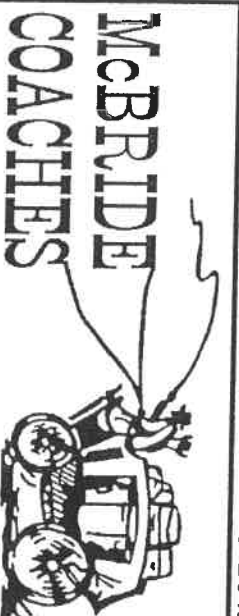

POLICE REPORT

On Friday, July 3, at 08:20, a complaint of three individuals on the roof of the McBride Elementary School, throwing rocks down the vents, was received. An investigation of mischief is ongoing. Also on Friday, July 3, police responded to a complaint of loud music in a residential area of McBride. The owner was advised of the municipal by-laws and of the Criminal Code charge of Mischief.

On July 5 at 07:42p.m. the McBride RCMP were called to a complaint of assault. A female had been punched resulting in her having to attend McBride Hospital for stitches. Attempts to locate the suspect were negative, and the investigation is ongoing. On July 7, police attended Dome Creek to a complaint of a female who had threatened others with a firearm, and threatened to shoot herself. The female was apprehended without incident, and was transported to Prince George Hospital. There are no charges at this time and police will be seeking to have the person prohibited from owning firearms.

The McBride RCMP would like to bring to your attention the following: It has been the practice of some companies to sell Satellite Dishes using American feeds. What sometimes occurs when these feeders are investigated by the CRTC is they cease providing the channels. This leaves the holder of the dish with a bill for the satellite and any months previously paid, sometimes amounting to two or more thousand dollars. Please be aware of the company you are purchasing a satellite dish from. A good practice would be to contact the Better Business Bureau at (604) 682-2711.

McBride RCMP report that on the evening of July 6, 1998 the suspect sought after in the high speed chase turned himself in to Police custody. Patrick Drew Wilson age 27 years of no fixed address has been charged with several Criminal Code and Motor Vehicle Act Offences. Wilson was escorted to Prince George and appeared in Provincial Court in Prince George on Tuesday, July 7, 1998. He was remanded in custody until July 10, 1998 and had pled guilty. The last unofficial word was that Wilson received 5 months in jail and 6 months probation.

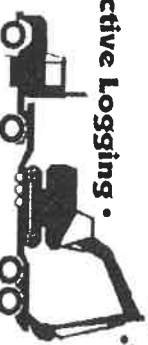
