## POLICE REPORT

On July 17, 1998 at 7:30p.m. C.N. Police advised McBride RCMP that a train crossing the Goat River Bridge narrowly missing individuals fishing off the Bridge.  
On July 18, 1998 at 8:18 p.m. a truck loaded with a buncher had pulled down a telephone line on Fifth Avenue in McBride. The operator of the truck was operating it inside the Village contrary to the conditions of the permit. The driver was charged. On July 19, 1998 at 1:37a.m. a McBride man was issued 1 24 hour driving suspension.  
On July 20, 1998 at 11:15p.m. McBride RCMP received a report that at the Small River rest stop a dog was attacked. The dog received severe injuries and was taken to a Prince George veterinary clinic for treatment. The dog was attacked by two larger dogs believed to be in the area.
