On behalf of everybody I would like to Thank all the Fire-Fighters, Forestry People, Robson Valley Recreation Center, The Red Cross, Volunteers and who ever else is involved in fighting these fires for all the time and effort you have put into saving our Community - Broom

Dore River Fire (5.5 KM West of McBride)- The danger has not lifted for the 140 homes in the Dore River subdivision. 110 Firefighters continue to attack the fire that has grown to approx. 2555 hectares. The fire has not moved closer to any homes and remains 4 km from the Dore River subdivision. High to Extreme Fire Danger rating is still in effect for the area. **General Info:** • Approx. 120 local residents have been hired and trained as emergency fire fighters for the Robson Valley area. • A bulletin Board is set up outside the entrance of the Ministry of Forests office that includes daily updated maps of the fire, fire report and weather forecasts. • The RED CROSS is recommending that residents on evacuation alert in the community of McBride call 1-800-565-8000 to register themselves leaving the affected area for an extended period of time. If residents in the affected area have any problems obtaining accommodations or food or clothing, please contact Dona Stapley at 569-3716.

Vancouver - cont. from last week... The RCMP also believes it is important to clarify that -it is misleading to suggest that there is a war on drugs which has either been won or lost. It would be more accurate to say that times have changed and the drug problem can no longer be solved using only law enforcement -Law enforcement remains a vital component of the overall substance-abuse strategy. To be effective, law enforcement agencies have to work together more closely and in partnership with the community, parents, youth groups, educators, social and health-care workers, the medical profession and legislators. Everyone has their role to play. - The recommendation that heroin be given to addicts at no cost in tightly-controlled trials was just one of the many observations made by Dr. Millar. The emphasis which has been placed upon this proposal has detracted from his overall message that education, prevention and drug rehabilitation programs are of primary importance. -Recent pilot projects in Sweden and Britain involving the controlled medical prescription of heroin actually resulted in increased rates of drug addiction, increased rates of related infectious disease and no reduction in crime rates. The injection drug problem in the Downtown Eastside is not just heroin-based. It is also cocaine-based. To be cont...

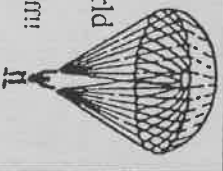

POLICE REPORT

On August 3rd, 1998 at 2:01 p.m., McBride RCMP responded to a single vehicle roll over on Highway 16, two kilometres east of McBride. The accident occurred when the driver of the vehicle fell asleep. An adult female was charged with driving without care and attention.

On August 5th, 1998 at 7:47 a.m. Police responded to a property line dispute near TRC Cedar Ltd. in McBride. The dispute was resolved informally at the time between the property owners. On August 6th, 1998 at 9:49 a.m. McBride RCMP responded to a complaint of theft of two gas powered water pumps from Zeidler Forest Industries Ltd. The pumps one model gp25 and the other model is gp45 and are both made by Shindaiwa. They have a combined value of \$1000.00. The pumps were taken out of a shed on the Zeidler property and are both painted blue. The pumps were taken sometime over the last two weeks. Anyone that may have information regarding the theft of these pumps is requested to contact the McBride RCMP.

On August 7th, at 11:46 a.m., McBride RCMP received a complaint of a possible theft of timber in the Crescent Spur area. Police attended with a Forestry Official. The logging operation was shut down due to the fire ban and police continue to investigate the allegation of theft.

McBride RCMP continue to liaise with several government and local agencies to monitor the forest fire in the Region.

During the past week McBride RCMP have attended several motor vehicle incidents as a result of vehicles hitting either a moose or a deer or attempting to avoid an animal and going off the road. Police would like to remind people particularly in the evening at night that the visibility is less and the animals are out so please slow down and have a safe summer.

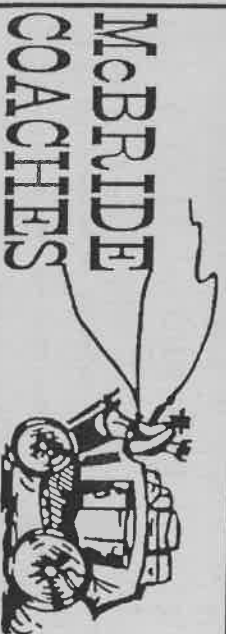

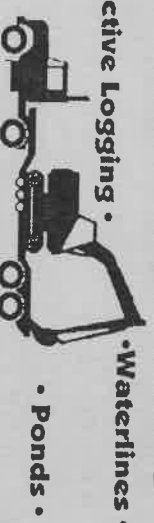
