POLICE REPORT

On August 14, 1998 the McBride RCMP in co-operation with B.C. Forestry recovered a stolen 1997 Honda ATV valued at approximately \$9,000.00. The ATV had been stolen out of Prince George. Investigation of two area residents continues in this matter.

Thanks to an alert and concerned citizen, McBride RCMP were able to attend the Holmes River on August 14, 1998 and apprehend several males near the water. Further investigation then allow police to lay charges of netting salmon and fishing in closed water against a young offender who cannot be named however resides in Prince George.

On August 15th, 1998 McBride RCMP responded to a complaint of two overdue hikers who had gone to hike Eng Mountain in the Catfish Creek area. With assistance from Search and Rescue and Forestry the two males both 24 years of age and experienced hikers were located in the early morning of August 16th still on the mountain where they had chosen to stay the night due to climate weather.

On August 15, 1998, McBride RCMP attend to a complaint of a single gun shot heard on Dorval Road. Attendance was made and no evidence found to support the complaint.

On August 19, 1998, McBride RCMP responded to a complaint of threats and possession of a weapon dangerous to public peace.

As a result a local male, Maurice Lalonde and appeared in Prince McBride, B.C. was taken into custody and appeared in Prince George Provincial Court on August 21st, 1998 and was released on bail pending his next court date set for September 4th, 1998 in McBride.

On August 20, 1998, McBride RCMP attend a break and enter at the tourist information booth in McBride. The thieves made off with approximately \$80.00 in cash. Police are asking anyone with information regarding this offence to please call the McBride RCMP Detachment.

On August 21st, 1998, McBride RCMP received a found pack sack. Anyone missing same can claim at the McBride Detachment. McBride RCMP would like to Thank the public and in the area residents affected by the Dore River Fire for their co-operation and assistance and patience during the time the evacuation alert was on.

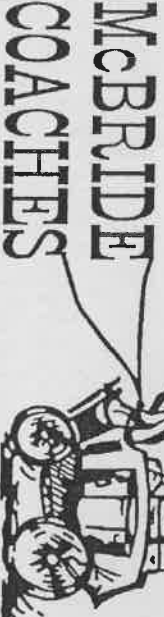
