Vancouver - The community needs to know the straight facts about drug addiction and the roll of law enforcement in addressing the overall solution. That is one of the conclusions offered by the RCMP following the release Tuesday of the report by provincial health officer Dr. John Millar on HIV, hepatitis and injection drug use in British Columbia. The report made a number of recommendations aimed at addressing the serious health crisis affecting Vancouver's Downtown Eastside and other areas of the province. "Dr. Millar's recommendations are consistent with our belief that what is needed here is an effective balance of prevention, education, treatment, demand reduction and strategic enforcement programs," said Insp. Richard Barszczewski, officer in charge of the RCMP's drug-awareness program in B.C. "Prevention, treatment and having all of the affected agencies work together in partnership is the key," said Barszczewski. To Be Continued...

The Northern Interior Regional Health Board is advising the public that public health clinics scheduled to take place at the Health Unit August 5, 6, & 7th will be cancelled. The decision to cancel the clinics is in anticipation of possible job action by Community Health Care Workers escalating to Prince George. The Clinics affected by the cancellations include the Sexually Transmitted Disease Clinic, the Travel Clinic and the Baby Clinic. While the clinics are being cancelled other services provided out of the Health Unit will continue to operate at a reduced, essential service level. These include some communicable disease services, Early Maternity Discharge follow up, Continuing Care Services such as Community Rehab and Home Nursing Care, Prince George Home Support Services. At this time the clinic and programs are affective Wednesday through Friday. The Public will be notified if further cancellations are necessary. 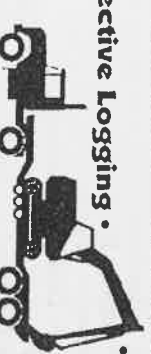
