Operation Impact Continues to Focus on High Risk Drivers-
Every year in Canada, 3,000 people die unnecessarily in motor
vehicle collisions. 25,000 suffer some type of serious injury, the
result of 675,000 collisions. That means the economy suffers at
a cost of \$10 billion dollars a year. More people are killed or
injured in traffic accidents than in homicides, assaults and all
other violent crimes combined. Need any more reasons why we
enforce traffic laws? Fortunately, many tragedies can be prevented
by knowing the facts. Did you know that through the simple act
of wearing a seat belt, or properly securing a child will increase
the chances of survival by 50 per cent? Did you also know that
over 33 per cent of drivers who die in vehicle crashes are
impaired? It's also been proven that a small group of Canadians,
approximately nine per cent, are high-risk drivers. The high-risk
driver doesn't wear a seat belt, drives after drinking and speeds.
"Operation Impact" is committed to making Canada's roads the
safest in the world by the year 2001. "Operation Impact" is a 24
hour, coast to coast, national traffic safety program with three
goals in mind: To save lives, to encourage partnership with other
police services to educate and communicate information about
these risks to the public. This year's "Operation Impact" will
take place Saturday, October 3, 1998. These education and
