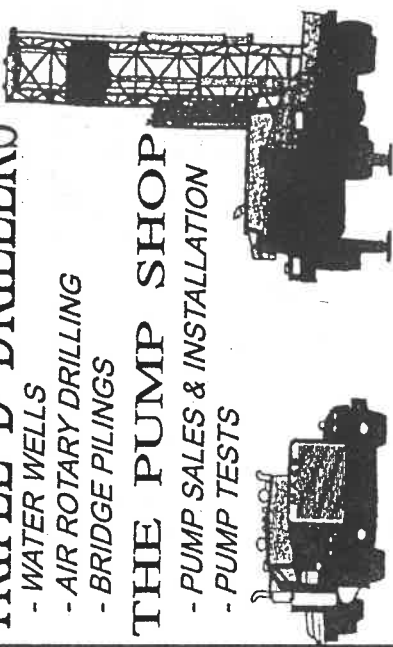

POLICE REPORT

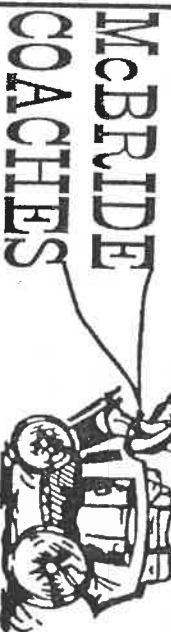
