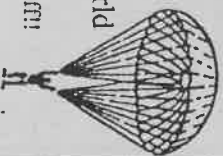

POLICE REPORT

On October 9, 1998, a complaint under the Water Act was received at 8:00 p.m. The complainant had his water shut off depriving he and his family of water for drinking, laundry, and cleaning, for four days. The investigation is ongoing. A report of a motor vehicle incident was received on October 9, 1998 at 8:40 p.m. The individual struck a bear on Highway 16, east of McBride. There were no injuries, however the vehicle had to be towed as a result of the damage it sustained. On Saturday, October 10, 1998 at about 10:00 p.m. a male was arrested for public intoxication under Section 43 of the Liquor Control and Licensing Act. He was incarcerated and later released when sober.

Also on Saturday, October 10, 1998, a male was given a twenty-four hour roadside suspension and had his vehicle towed when he was found to have consumed over the legal limit of alcohol while driving. The McBride RCMP wish to remind the motoring public that a roadside suspension may be issued when the blood alcohol content of an individual found to be driving is over 50 milligrams of alcohol in 100 millilitres of blood. Also it is the responsibility of the driver or owner of the vehicle to pay all costs associated to the tow.

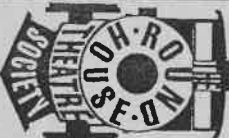
