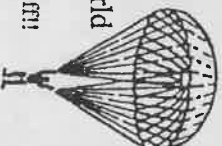

RHA, RHA, We're ONE! -The Robson Health Association has
just passed the one year anniversary of incorporation. In May
1998 the membership of 260 elected a board of twelve
representatives: Susan Beeson, Rita Rewerts, Erica Roberts, Ruth
Van Velzen, Ann Kiyooka, Irma Brownlee, Pete Amyonyo, Dean
Coder, Marilyn Wheeler, Linda Fry and Al Howe. These people
are carrying on a long tradition of dedicated perseverance to
improving local health services. Starting with care in private
homes, then a Red Cross Outpost hospital in 1938, then a
Hospital Society in 1955 which opened the present hospital in
1963. Valemount started with motel-room clinics, a converted
house and finally opened the present building in 1976. By the
1990's Valemount and McBride worked jointly on many health
initiatives. 1993 saw the start of New Directions, the steering
committee evolved into a Community Health Council (CHC). Yet
another change in 1996 saw the dissolution of the Boards of the
hospital, health centre, and the CHC. The Northern Interior
Regional Health Board was formed with Bill Arnold and Joan
Nordli being appointed to represent the Robson Valley. The
Robson Health Association was formed to continue and ensure
the long tradition of local involvement with health care. Most
recently the Robson Health Association has been involved in the
physician recruitment process and a review of the Robson Valley
Health Plan. Regular monthly meetings are open to the public
and held the fourth Monday at 7:00 p.m. at Dunster. Our next
meeting is Nov. 23, we'd love to see you there! Please contact

POLICE REPORT

McBride RCMP responded to a single vehicle roll over, approximately 18 kms. east of McBride on Hwy. 16 on October 24th. A 1998 Chev Cavalier was written off and the driver and lone occupant from McBride received minor injuries despite being ejected from the vehicle during the roll. Driver error was the cause of the accident.

On October, 27th police responded to a call of break, enter and theft on Dore River Road. An attached garage was broken into and two snowmobiles were stolen. The snowmobiles taken were a 1997 ARCTIC CAT, Model ZRT-600, Serial number 9754237, black in color and a 1996 SKI DOO MXZ-580, Serial number 109400116, bright yellow in color.

-The frame of the SKI DOO was recovered later the same day on the Dore River Forestry Road. The engine, skis and track had been removed. To date, these items along with the ARCTIC CAT have not been recovered. The McBride RCMP are asking anyone with information regarding this or any other offence to please call the McBride RCMP.
