Police Report

Due to recent coroads, McBride •It is illegal to open complaints of snowmobiles operating illegally on le RCMP would like to remind those operating responsibilities:

•It is illegal to operate snow machines on or across highways. A highway by definition under the Highways Act includes all roads, bridges, trails, lanes, streets, trestles, ferry landings, approaches and any other public way. All roads other than private roads are deemed common and public highways.

•In British Columbia every owner of a snowmobile must register their sled with the insurance Corporation of British Columbia. At

their sled with the insurance Corporation of British Columbia. At that time the owner will be provided with an owner certificate and registration decals. The decals should be affixed to each side of the snowmobiles cowl or another conspicuous place on each side of the snowmobile. The certificate upon demand is to be made available for inspection by an enforcement officer.

It is illegal to operate a snowmobile without a helmet.

It is illegal to operate a snowmobile in a careless, reckless or negligent manner so as to endanger or cause injury or damage to a person or property of another.

It is illegal to operate a snowmobile on the tracks of an operating railway.

operating, railway.
•It is illegal to operate a snowmobile on private property without

the owners consent.

•It is illegal to operate a snowmobile in a manner as to drive, harass, chase, run over, injure or kill wildlife or domestic animals.

•It is illegal to operate a snowmobile in a tree nursery or damage or destroy growing

•It is illegal to operate a snowmobile while having consumed alcohol or drug in such a manner that a persons ability to operate that snowmobile is impaired.
