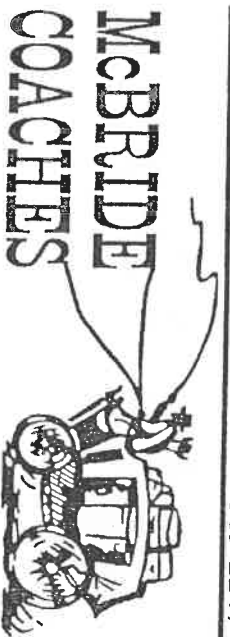

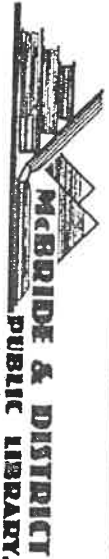

HTML files are meant to be viewed using a World Wide Web Client Program, such as Netscape or Mosaic.
