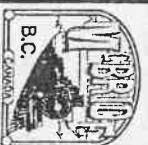

POLICE REPORT

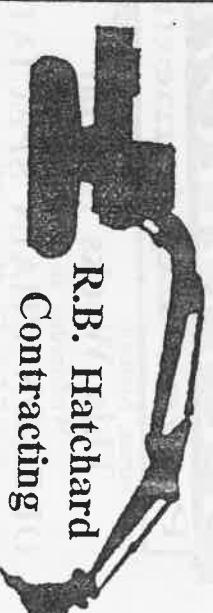
