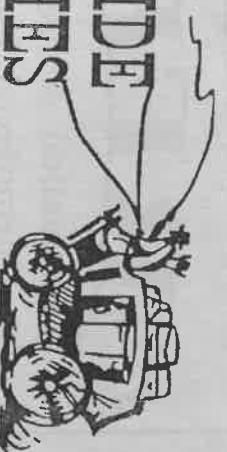

THE LITTLE TOWN THAT COULD

It's time to shake off the snowflakes and get involved in the upcoming THEATRESCAPE '99 (drama festival). This is a good opportunity for drama students from our school and other BC schools to get together for a week of productions, workshops, and cross-school socializing. Our drama students have been on several such trips and have found the experience unbelievable - now it is McBRIDE's turn to create these same experiences for other schools. The most needed community support needed at this time is for HOST FAMILIES to billet our out-of-town guests. Our students have always been treated wonderfully when they were guests in Prince George and it is a great thing to extend the same generous hospitality to our guests. We need the community's help to make this a successful festival. Without the support the festival may not happen. WHAT IS INVOLVED - Host families are needed from March 2 to March 6. The host families are asked to provide a floor space, couch, or bed for students. The only meal the host will need to provide is breakfast. The visiting students come prepared with sleeping bags, pillow, and personal needs. The host families need to ensure students can get to workshops by 9:00 am and home after 10:30 pm after the performances have finished. The host families are also required by the School District to submit to a Police check. This is a simple form to complete. "WHY SHOULD I SUBMIT TO THIS CHECK?" you ask yourself. Students' parents will rest easier knowing the host families have been checked. Consider how you have felt or may feel if your child has ever needed to be billeted for any school trip. "WHY SHOULD I HAVE THOSE KIDS IN MY HOUSE?" you ask. The teachers that will be travelling with children would not consider bringing them if they felt any one would create a problem and the kids view this as privilege to come. Host families will be able to contact the Festival coordinator and/or the visiting teacher at any time that a problem arises. WHY SHOULD YOU BECOME INVOLVED - This is a GREAT opportunity for McBride and McBride Secondary. The visiting students have chosen to be billeted due to the extra cost of motels. As a present student parent is ACUTELY aware that any out of town trip can be costly. PLACE YOURSELVES IN THEIR SHOES. Most parents have clear memories of all the fund-raisers they have done or have to face for their children's trips. If we can not find enough billets this will mean more fund-raising for the schools to get here to cover motel costs OR it may mean the schools may have to pull out of the festival. This would be a great tragedy as this could be a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for many students. One day your child could be in need of billeting - wouldn't it be nice to know that other towns would show the same courtesy to you? If you can not be persuaded by the community spirit appeal, take a moment to think of the possible financial benefits for McBride in our current economic situations. Including visiting bus drivers, teachers, and students, many need to eat lunch and suppers for four days. Our restaurants and convenience stores would benefit, as well as some of our motels for the students who have chosen to utilize their services. Buses need gas and other supplies. BUT, THE FUTURE BENEFIT FOR McBRIDE - up to 200 visitors to McBride go home (some as far away as Quesnel to Mackenzie) and talk about the great and generous time presented by US. The word of mouth potential is overwhelming. 200 sets of parents happy, teachers happy, and all telling other family members and friends BC wide and farther. Those of you who have said "NO" without finding out more information, it is hoped that you will have second thoughts.
