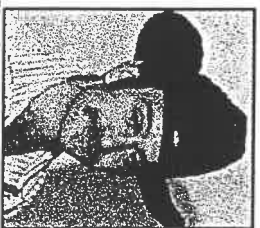

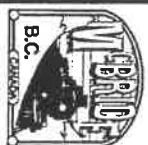

### D.A.R.E. To Change

With the arrival of spring, the attention of many individuals turns to gardening, a yearly ritual where seeds are planted in fertile ground and nurtured so that a bountiful harvest can be reaped at a later time. Recently, I was fortunate to observe the planning of another kind of seed, one that was taking root in the minds of McBride's Grade Five Students. At the invitation of Constable Tim Alexander, of the McBride RCMP, I sat in with the Grade Five students and observed a D.A.R.E. (Drug Abuse Resistance Education) class. The D.A.R.E. program was founded in 1983 in Los Angeles, and was designed to give children the skill needed to recognize and resist the subtle and over pressure that caused them to experiment with alcohol, drugs, or become involved in gangs. More than 35 million young people benefit this non-profit program, which operates in 44 countries around the world. In Canada, the D.A.R.E. program is administered through the RCMP. Officers receive eighty hours of special training prior to facilitating the 17 week school-based program. Currently, the local D.A.R.E. program is directed at the McBride Grade Five Students with the expressed goal of expanding to other grades. Students were supplied with a workbook covering a variety of topics, such as "How To Make A Decision," as was the topic on the day I attended. The students actively participated in the learning, asking intelligent and relevant questions, drawing from Constable Alexander's experience, and showed a high level of enthusiasm. Once the program has been completed, each student will take part in a graduation ceremony, with parents and members of the community present. Graduation gifts of D.A.R.E. T-Shirts, stickers and other desirable items are supplied, reminding students of what they had learnt during the program. As an observer, it was easy to see how the D.A.R.E. program could become so successful. It is a collaborative effort involving the police, parents, school and the community. The children are surrounded with support and encouragement from all sides. As a mental health clinician, I am very supportive of this program and invite everyone else in our community to support D.A.R.E. 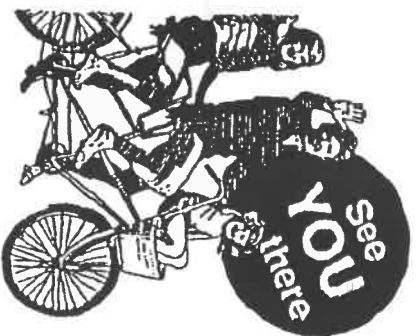

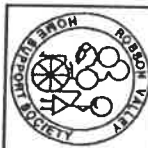
