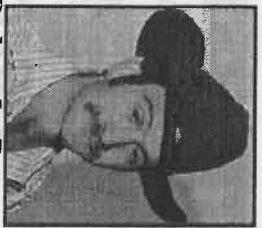

ROBSON VALLEY HAZARD LAND STUDY

HAZ 1.1

The Regional Board of the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George announces completion of an overview hazard land study of a portion of the Robson Valley. This portion of the study covers the Fraser River corridor from Lamming Mills upstream through to Tete Juane Cache and Mount Robson. The part of the valley extending south to Albreda is still under review and is not yet complete.

The Regional District commissioned this engineering study to provide information for property owners and residents, land developers, future land owners and realtors. While the study identifies areas of risk it also shows large areas of the valley where further geotechnical engineering studies should generally not be required for building permit or subdivision applications.

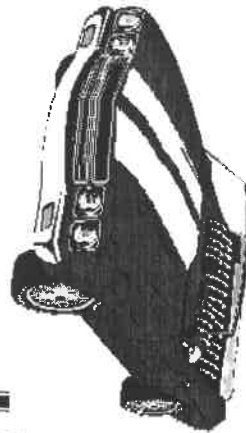
Areas where geotechnical engineer's assessments have in the past been required as a prerequisite to development have now been further defined in the Study. **Property owners with affected lands are being notified by mail.** Geotechnical engineering studies will continue to be required in these affected areas as part of a building permit, subdivision or rezoning application.

There will be Open Houses, followed by Public Meetings, to discuss the implications of this study as follows:

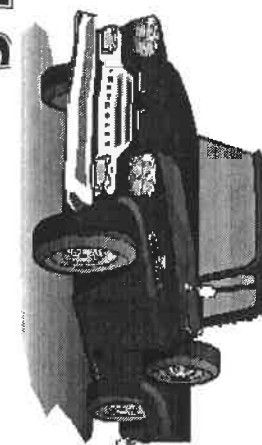

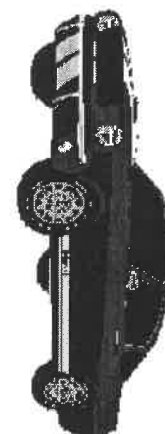
