Several ways to do this are: hold a quilting bee, make a quilt for a friend or relative, take a quilt class, encourage the local library to feature quilt books, teach your children to thread a needle, or get your sewing machine cleaned and tuned. In response to National Quilt Month, the Valley Piecemakers' Quilt Guilds held a quilt show on May 1 at the Roundhouse Theatre in McBride. 170 quilted works were on display for the public to enjoy. As well, the guild has made a charity quilt which will be given away. At the Guild's wind-up dinner on May 17, 1999, a decision was made to donate all of the proceeds from the raffle quilt to support local causes. \$250 was given to the village for play equipment in the Village park, \$250 will be given as a bursary to a graduating student at the McBride Secondary, \$100 was given to the McBride and District Hospital garden project to purchase shrubs, and \$100 was given to the McBride Secondary Counter Attack group. The Valley Piecemakers' Guild meets every second Monday evening from September to May. Membership is open to people of all ages, from beginners to advanced. The first meeting in the fall is scheduled for Monday, September 20, 1999, at 7:00 p.m. at the McBride Secondary School.
