POLICE REPORT

June 6 - Police responded to a call of a two car motor vehicle accident at the intersection of Highway 16 and Bridge Road. There were no injuries, however both vehicles suffered extensive damage when a red Toyota crossed Highway 16 southbound and was struck by an eastbound Ford pickup. The driver of the Toyota was charged under for Unsafe Start From a Stop contrary to section 169 of the Motor Vehicle Act.

June 7 - At approximately 11:30p.m., police were called to a single motor vehicle accident eighteen kilometres east of McBride. The car struck a moose which sent it into the ditch where it rolled over twice before coming to rest. The driver, a twenty-three year old female and her six month old daughter were transported to the McBride Hospital for observation. They were released the following day. The vehicle sustained extensive damage. There were no charges.

June 10 - Police responded to a complaint of a disturbance on Main Street at about 09:00a.m. There was a discrepancy whereby one party stated the other owed him money for work rendered. The matter was resolved informally.

June 10 - A complaint of two horses running on the highway at around 10:00a.m. The horses, with the assistance of members of the general public were rounded up. The owner was notified and retrieved the horses.

June 11- McBride R.C.M.P. are investigating a fatal motor vehicle accident which occurred at approximately 10:00p.m. on June 11, 1999. The accident occurred on Highway 16 West, 71 kilometres West of McBride. The driver of the vehicle Chris Andrew, age 62 was killed when the 1994 Mazda van he was driving caught the side shoulder of the highway causing the vehicle to go into a steep embankment. ANDREW was thrown from the vehicle and died as a result of his injuries. Two female passengers in the vehicle received non life threatening injuries. One of the passengers were taken to the Prince George Hospital while the other was transported to the McBride Hospital. Police believe that none of the occupants were wearing seatbelts at the time of the accident. Investigation of this incident is continuing and initial indications are that alcohol was a contributing factor.
