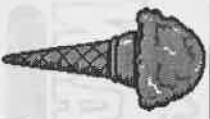

POLICE REPORT

On June 12, 1999 McBride RCMP were notified of a traffic hazard on Highway 16 near Legrand Road. A flat deck trailer with a flat tire was found parked partially on the west bound driving lane. As it was dark this did indeed present a hazard and when the owner was advised and not available to remove the trailer, it was towed to ensure the public's safety on the road. McBride RCMP also responded to a single vehicle accident on Highway 16 approximately 11 kilometres west of McBride on June 12th. The vehicle had struck a moose on the roadway. The occupants of the vehicle from Crescent Spur were shaken but not injured.

On June 13, 1999 McBride RCMP seized 2850 tablets of amphetamines as a result of a search of the vehicle involved in the fatal accident on June 11, 1999 on Highway 16 near Walker Creek Road. No charges are pending as a result of the seizure. A Complaint of an erratic driver was received on June 14, 1999 and resulted in an informal resolution when police spoke with the driver.

McBride RCMP will be participating in the ICBC UNSAFE Speed Campaign from June 30th to July 6th. Police will be looking at a variety of offences as well as speeding.

UNSAFE SPEED

Unsafe speed is a leading cause of crashes in British Columbia. Many other aggressive and dangerous driving habits are often associated with unsafe speed. These include following too closely (tailgating), unsafe and sudden lane changes and running red lights. SPEED • It's a contributing factor in 35% of all fatal motor vehicle crashes • In 1997 police reported 6,600 unsafe related collisions on BC roads and the total claims costs associated with unsafe speed and dangerous driving amounted to approximately \$550 million. • Automobile crashes injure some every 11 minutes in British Columbia and claim a life every 21 hours - 180 people are killed and 8,000 injured as a result of unsafe speed related collisions.
