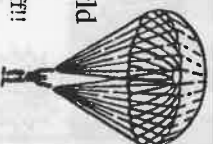

LETTER TO THE EDITOR

This article in no way reflects the opinion of The Little McBride Paper.

I immigrated to the Robson Valley in 1979. On June 24th, 1999, the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George declared my beautiful property and the land of 750 others to be "identified as being in a potentially hazardous area....The frequency of hazard is estimated to be at least one event in 500 years." I and my neighbours have been notified that "no dwelling on property in high hazard areas can be improved or repaired in a way that will extend the normal life of the building." My property has been designated as being in a snow avalanche area, even though there has been no avalanche of any kind in living memory.

I came to the Robson Valley to enjoy it's scenic splendour and pleasant life style. All that I have worked for has been wiped out with the stroke of a pen. No doubt the Regional District will use "logic" to explain all the good they've just done, but where is the logic to owning a home worth millions up in Whistler, where people regularly die in hazards, compared to the same home in Dunster, where there hasn't been a slide, avalanche, etc., etc., etc. since anyone can remember, that is worth nothing. Explain that. And the same board tells me that now if a tree falls and damages my home, I am forbidden to repair it. I ask you, readers, would you just sit there and let the water pour in?

So why have we been singled out? Conditions in many other areas, including some very densely populated areas, would indicate a much higher probability of "Hazard" than exists in this valley. This "Robson Valley Hazard Land Study" was prepared with old aerial maps and a geotechnical student who reportedly came to the Robson Valley and got out of her car only twice. The many highly qualified experts who live in the Robson Valley all agree that this basis for a decision is beyond foolishness. Yet they were insulted and ignored by the Regional Board.

In my opinion the behaviour of the Regional Board and it's proponents are showing the citizens they supposedly represent is dishonourable, dishonest and shameful. The callous disregard of this board towards the hopes and dreams of others disgraces me, and makes me ashamed to call myself a Canadian.

I am dismayed that the government of Canada, a country I hold dear, would sit back and allow such a thing to happen to it's citizens. Authority that allows a small group to destroy the life's work and inheritance of it's neighbours should be forbidden. I thought justice and fairness was equally shared by every citizen of Canada. This decision by the Regional Board proves that it depends on where you live as to what kind of justice you can expect to receive.

EXPERIMENT OF THE WEEK

POLICE REPORT

July 1 - A male and a female were arrested for assault, and uttering threats. The two were released on an undertaking with conditions and a promise to appear in court at a later date.
July 1 - At about 10:30p.m. two males exited a local restaurant without paying their bill totaling approximately \$80. The two were located by police a short time later. The matter was resolved without charges when the bill was paid.
July 2 - Police attended a dispute at approximately 10p.m. There was no evidence to support the allegations made and the matter was resolved without incident between the two parties.

July 6 - As a result of several complaints of speeding within the Village, the McBride RCMP will be strictly enforcing the speed limits. The voluntary penalty for speeding within a municipality is a minimum \$115 and points.
July 10 - Sometime during the night a person or persons gained entry to the McBride Tourist Information Booth and made off with a cash box. Anyone with information is asked to phone the detachment
July 11 - At about 09:30 a male was suspended for driving for a period of 24 hours when he failed a roadside screening test.
July 12 - At about 01:00 a.m. the same evening a second male was issued a 24 hour suspension when he failed the roadside screening test. The vehicle was towed at the owner's expense.
July 12 - At approximately 12:00 noon a vehicle was stolen from Dome Diner. Police attended and attempted to locate the two males, but all checks were negative. At about 06:00 p.m. the two males committed a theft from a store in Edson, Alberta. There they were found and pursued by the Edson RCMP for almost 120 kilometres reaching top speeds of 130 kilometres per hour. They were eventually stopped and the two, one adult and one juvenile face several charges including possession of stolen property.

July 16 - At about 09:00 a.m. police attended a single accident on Highway 16 West. There was extensive damage to the pickup and both the driver and passenger were injured. The driver was transported to Prince George General Hospital while the passenger was taken to the McBride Hospital. The extent of the injuries are unknown.
