Yellowhead (HWY. 16). On Oct. 15/16 and 17 the artisans
between Hinton, Alberta and McBride, B.C. have opened their
studios for the October Roads Studio Tour. "If you have ever
wondered about the process that evolves between picking up a
brush and the painting that emerges, or how an object materializes
from within a block of clay or soapstone... then experience an
unforgettable glimpse into the creative environment of the studio."
The weekend begins with an opportunity to meet Canadian artist
Barb Brooks at the Jasper Museum, a show of her traditional
images in her non-traditional medium of inks. Friday evening
could take in the Cashore Marionettes at the Roundhouse Theatre
in McBride. Saturday can be spent wandering the beautiful
mountain community checking out potters and painters... Sunday
morning stretch your legs with a walkabout at the Jasper Park
Lodge with author and historian, Lisa Christensen, while she
points out the peaks and lakes that were experienced by artists
Lauren Harris and Ay Jackson when they painted here in 1924.
Or perhaps get off the beaten track with a visit to two beautiful
mountain guest ranches north of Hinton. You set the pace! Artists
