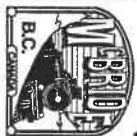

GOPING WITH GRIEF

Grief and loss touch us all. Death of a loved one, divorce, loss of employment, loss of friendship, are but a few examples. When there is a trauma amongst us, there is strong support of those who are grieving, even though at times it is difficult to know what to say or how to be supportive. It is important to remember that grieving and mourning is a long process, not something that is over after three or four months. Reconciliation can take years and the overall effects are with us a lifetime. The more we understand about this process, the easier it is to cope with our own grief and to be supportive of friends and loved ones who are grieving. Through funding from the Northern Interior Health Board, a professional grief counsellor and seminar facilitator is coming to our community to present an "Understanding Grief Seminar" and "Grief and Loss Workshop". ### IMMUNIZATION WEEK

October 24-30 is National Immunization Week in Canada and  
the Northern Interior Regional Health Board wants residents to be  
aware of the importance and effectiveness of immunization.

The Regional Health Board coordinates immunization efforts through  
three age groups: infants and preschoolers, school-age and adolescent  
and adult.

Regional Health Board Medical Health Officer Dr. Lorna Medd  
says immunization is one of the most important measures we  
have to prevent disease, and definitely one of the most cost  
effective. Most of the vaccine-preventable diseases are now rare  
in BC and Canada. However, she cautions that if the population  
is not protected, these diseases can spread quickly. International  
travel, for example, provides a risk of exposing people here to  
diseases like polio or measles.

It is important that parents adhere to their children's vaccination  
schedule so that maximum protection is provided. Dr. Medd  
notes that in 1996, Canada had the highest rate of measles in the  
Americas. "In spite of this, five to ten percent of Canadian  
parents are ambivalent about childhood immunization while a  
large number of the children who are vaccinated do not receive  
their shots on time.

In this area, the percentage of school aged children receiving  
vaccinations is quite high. Dr. Medd attributes this to the support  
and cooperation of the local school districts in assisting with the  
program.
