Issues have recently been raised around a draft proposal for financial assistance to individual property owners requiring geotechnical study of their property, therefore the Regional District is issuing this release. • The proposal was considered at the November 18, 1999 open public meeting of the Regional Board. At that meeting, the Board tabled the recommendation. No further action will be taken until the newly elected Board lifts the proposal from the table. The earliest date the proposal can be lifted from the table is January 20, 2000. This is the first regular Board meeting after the new Board is sworn in on December 16, 1999. \*SUMMARY:\* The proposed service was to apply to Electoral Area 'H' (Robson Valley-Canoe) of the Regional District of Fraser-Fort George. It would not apply within the Villages of McBride and Valemount. Before it can be implemented, the proposed Bylaw No. 1881, 1999 requires four readings by the Regional Board, approval of the electors and approval by the Inspector of Municipalities. It would be funded by a low level of property taxation, applicable only to properties in Electoral Area 'H'. The taxation would not apply to properties within the Villages of McBride and Valemount.
