## LIBRARY NEWS

McBride is the newest home to a book detailing what will likely  
be one of the next land claims treaties in B.C. Margaret Griffiths,  
librarian for the McBride and District Public Library, recently  
accepted a treaty information binder from representatives of the  
Canadian and B.C. governments as well as the Lheidli T'enneh  
First Nation. In a ceremony marking the presentation on October  
26, negotiators from all three parties thanked the library and the  
community for hosting the presentation. The book contains the  
first ten chapters of what will become the Lheidli T'enneh treaty.  
It is available through the library. Negotiations towards completing  
the treaty took place in McBride Oct. 26-27. The talks in  
McBride included the release of three new chapters detailing how  
the three groups plan to approve and ratify the treaty. Another  
chapter on Environmental Assessment information was also released.  
About 30 people attended the open Main Table meeting Oct. 26  
at the Village Office. Negotiations came to McBride at the  
invitation of Mayor Maurice Bonneville, who sits as part of the  
B.C. team on the treaty talks. Wilf Adam, Commissioner of the  
B.C. Treaty Commission, was on hand to witness the negotiations  
and take part in the library ceremony.

## POLICE REPORT

**October 18-** Police responded to a single motor vehicle accident on Hwy. 16 a few kilometres east of the Holmes bridge. A resident of Edmonton was travelling to McBride when his car struck a deer on the roadway. No injuries were reported, however the car suffered extensive damage and had to be towed away. **Police would like to remind** all motorists to slow down their speed at night-time. By doing so, they will increase their chances of seeing the animals along the side of the roads and minimizing the risk of an accident.

**October 19-** An attempt break and enter was reported at Bigway Foods on Main St. The investigation revealed that sometime during the night of October 15 to 16, someone attempted to gain entry to the rear of the business by using a power tool. **October 20-** A report of a hit and run was reported. A local resident discovered that his red 1997 four wheel drive Subaru was hit by an unknown vehicle. It is unknown when the accident happened, therefore anyone that may have witnessed the incident is asked to contact the local detachment.
