POLICE REPORT

December 31, 1999 - At approximately 14:00 hrs., a rental car from Manitoba was travelling west on Hwy 16 near Le Grand Rd. when the driver lost control. The vehicle spun into the oncoming traffic lane and came to a stop in the ditch. The vehicle suffered of extensive damage, however no injury was reported. The two occupants were heading to Prince George to return the car.
