At the meeting that was held in regards to the closure of the Preschool, the question regarding the actual assets - money in bank was raised. This question raised a lot of concerns as to how it might benefit the greatest number of people in the Valley. After a lengthy discussion it was decided that all money in the bank will be passed over to the Village Park Enhancement Project. Our decision was based on the past 25 years of parent participation in fundraisers and of the community and business support of all our fundraisers. The money will be returned back to the community to benefit the children and grandchildren of all the people who have helped us in one way or another. After March 31, 2000 a decision will be made on the distribution of our fundraisers - again based on the greatest number of people to benefit.
