POLICE REPORT

On April 8 at 11:22 a.m. McBride RCMP responded to a call of a house fire in the 4600 block of Mountainview Road. The residents of the house had managed to extinguish the fire which had started in a bedroom when some burning incense ignited the carpet and began to spread. The bedroom area suffered minor fire damage however the smoke damage was extensive. Had the residents not been successful in extinguishing the fire it would have been quickly out of control.

On April 8 at 2:17p.m., police responded to a single vehicle roll over on Highway 16 three kilometres east of McBride. The driver, a local resident, and his two young sons were transported to McBride Hospital by Ambulance where they were examined, treated for minor injuries and released. The accident occurred when the driver fell asleep in part due to the warm weather of the day. A reminder to motorists that if you are feeling drowsy pull over and take a few minutes to get out and stretch and get some fresh air. If your really tired take a nap before continuing your travel.

On April 10 McBride RCMP responded to a dog complaint in the rural area. Pet owners are reminded that they are responsible for their pets and can be held criminally and civilly responsible.

On April 11 police responded to a call of threats. All parties involved were spoken to and the matter was resolved informally.

On April 12 at 8:11p.m. police were called to an injury accident on Highway 16 at Ptarmigan Creek. A pickup from Saskatchewan left the roadway when the motor stalled and travelled about one hundred feet down the embankment demolishing the truck. The driver, also from Saskatchewan, was treated at McBride hospital for minor injuries and released.

On April 14 police received a letter from a local resident. The letter was sent to the area resident from Nigeria requesting bank account information to enable them to deposit money into the account. We saw several of these letters in the Valley last year and want to remind everyone that this is a scam. Anyone receiving these letters are asked to bring them into the McBride Detachment so we can keep track of them.
