Carpal Tunnel Syndrome

In my experience, Carpal Tunnel problems affect the forearm, wrist and hand are usually easily rectified with 5-7 acupuncture treatments. It is almost always as the result of occupational or other trauma and the resulting trigger points that have formed in the muscles of the forearm, elbow, arm shoulder, back and neck.
