## POLICE REPORT

On April 29, a resident of Fort St. John was pulled over as he was driving his vehicle without any licence plates on it. Subsequent enquiries revealed that the driver was prohibited from driving by the Superintendent of the Motor Vehicle Branch. The vehicle was impounded and the driver will be appearing in court to answer to the charge.

On April 30, a report was received that a red pickup truck bearing Alberta plates was passing vehicles in an unsafe manner on Hwy. 16 east of McBride. Patrol was made, however the vehicle was not located.

On May 2, the McBride Detachment was informed by McBride Secondary School that a grade 9 student was suspended for one week. The suspension resulted after the student pulled a knife on another student while in class.

On May 2, the McBride RCMP responded to a 911 call from a resident of Dunster. The elderly male had fell into a pond near his property and caught his arm in a beaver trap. Fortunately, the male was able to cut the wire that keeps the trap under water. He then made it back to his vehicle and drove home with the trap attached to his arm. The trap was later removed from his arm and the individual was transported to McBride Hospital for observation. The RCMP would like to Thank Dr. Tom Vogel and his wife as well as the McBride Fire Rescue volunteers and Ambulance attendants that helped in this delicate situation.

On May 4, a young female was approached by a 39 year old male driving a blue pickup truck on 3rd avenue in McBride. Even though the male indicated to the RCMP that he was new in town and looking for work, the investigation revealed that the male was asking a lot of personal questions to the adolescent. The RCMP would like to remind all residents to be cautious of strangers and not to get in their vehicles when offered. Any similar incidents should be IMMEDIATELY reported to your local detachment.
