## BICYCLE SAFETY

More than 40,000 people are involved in a bicycle accident each year. Many of these could have been prevented. Cyclists usually do not pay enough attention to the traffic. This is especially true for children. They misjudge their speed, their reaction time, the speed of the cars, and the difficulty of the situation. Cyclists seem to forget that they are very "fragile" compared to a car.

One big aspect in bicycle safety is being able to share the road with cars and / or pedestrians. Cyclist should always drive on the right side of the lane (except when making a left hand turn). If you have to make any turns, always shoulder check first, then signal, and then turn. A lot of accidents occur because the cyclist just turned without checking if a vehicle is coming from behind. If you are approaching an intersection watch out for pedestrians that might want to cross the road. At an intersection always yield the right of way, even to pedestrians. Do not try to take your right of way. If you are passing by parked cars take extra caution. Pedestrians might be standing between two cars and try to cross the road. They might step out suddenly because they have not seen you yet. Also a careless driver could open the door in your path. If possible allow four feet between you and parked cars.

If you must ride when it is dark, make sure you wear light colored clothing. Also make sure your reflectors are clean and your lights work well. It is very hard for a driver to see a cyclist, who has no lights or reflectors, in the dark.

In B.C. it is law to wear a bicycle helmet. It has saved lives and it can save your life too. Do not hit the road without a helmet. It is not very comfortable wearing a helmet but if you have gotten into an accident, the weeks of hospital afterwards are even more uncomfortable.

Biking involves a lot of common sense. Many bike accidents can be prevented just by taking an extra second and do a shoulder check or just simply slow down.

I love biking and have taken my bike to many places. I did not have an accident yet and I hope that it is going to stay that way. I think that if, one always obeys those rules mentioned above one will not get into an accident.
