VICTORY IN THE FIGHT AGAINST IMPAIRED DRIVING

OTTAWA, June 30, 2000...Dick Harris, Canadian Alliance MP for Prince George-Bulkley Valley welcomed the final step in his fight against impaired driving. Bill C-18 which enables judges to impose a life sentence on individuals convicted of impaired driving causing death was given Royal Assent on Thursday, June 29th. "This has been a long and arduous process but the results are well worth it. Bill C-18, in addition to increasing the maximum penalty for impaired driving causing death also provides for the taking of blood samples for the purpose of testing for drugs. As well, Increased penalties for the crime of impaired driving were enacted last summer," said Harris. Harris concluded "These new penalties for impaired driving will provide a high level of deterrence for those who choose to drink and drive. Canadians now look forward to safer streets and highways."
