MCBRIDE RECEIVES FUNDING TO REVITALIZE TRAIN STATION • The McBride and Area Economic Development Commission will receive \$49,000 towards revitalizing a historic train station, Prince George-Mount Robson M-LA Lots Boone announced on behalf of Jenny Kwan, minister of community development, cooperatives and volunteers. • The funding from the Community Enterprise program will be used to manage the work on McBride's 1920 train station, to be used as a tourism and business resource centre, and as a showcase for local artisans. • "The Centre will provide a focal point for economic development and diversification, as well as for cultural development in the Robson Valley", said Boone. • "This is a good example of the way our ministry supports communities to shape their own futures", said Kwan. "Local people and organizations have given this issue a lot of thought and come up with a viable, made-in-McBride approach to building the local economy and enriching the local culture." • "The Goal is to make service sector stronger while offering tourists the chance to appreciate local arts and crafts in a unique heritage setting," said economic development commission chair Dona Stapely. • Mayor Mike Frazier added that the train station project has wide support throughout the community. • "The Village, the Chamber of Commerce, the local businesses inside and outside the municipality, our prospective entrepreneurs, the Valley Museum and Archive Society and the Robson Wood Processors Association are all eager to work with the development commission to make this project a success", he said. • Northern development commissioner John Backhouse said McBride is on the right track by promoting the growth of the service sector. • "It's one component of the northern economy that's virtually guaranteed to grow in the coming years", he said. • Community Enterprise provides support to communities to implement local economic and social development plans and help co-operatives enter niche markets. 


