POLICE REPORT

On September 1, 2000, at approximately 10:00p.m. a local resident was stopped for speeding on Hwy. 16. The Driver showed some signs of impairment which resulted in a 24 hour driving prohibition. Some alcohol was also seized from the vehicle.
 Also on September 1st the RCMP received a report of a single motor vehicle accident on hwy 16 approximately 25 kilometres east of McBride. The young female driver, who is from Prince George, crossed the centre line and ended up in the ditch after swerving around the deer. The driver suffered of minor injury. On September 2, at approximately 9:00p.m., the RCMP attempted to stop a vehicle for speeding on Hwy. 16 approximately 10 kilometres west of McBride. The vehicle turned off on a side road and continued on until it stopped in someone's driveway. The driver, a local resident who was uncooperative and intoxicated, was brought back to the police station for a Breathalyzer. The investigation revealed that the driver exceeded the legal limit of 0.8 by almost 4 times and was charged with impaired driving. There was three calls of alarms in the McBride area on September 5. All were attended and reported as false.

On September 5 there was also a report of a lost purse at the Slim Creek Rest Area near Dome Creek. The police remind everyone that if you find someone elses property that it is best to turn it into the RCMP.
 Also on the 5th of September, the McBride RCMP received a report that the A-Frame cabin near the cross-country ski trails on Bell Mountain had been vandalized sometime over the summer. Also, some 4x4 vehicles have been driving down the trails and destroyed some of them. Anyone with information regarding these incidents is asked to call the McBride RCMP.
 On September 7, there was a report of an accident 40km east of McBride near Horsey Creek on Hwy. 16. The driver, who is from Mississippi, dozed off and drove into the ditch. The female passenger was taken to McBride Hospital for minor back injury. Also on the September 7, the McBride RCMP received a report from the Tele Janne Scales that a truck and trailer unit heading west bound on Hwy. 16, failed to report at the scales. The truck was located in McBride and the driver was advised to return to the Scales.
 On September 8, 2000, the RCMP received a report of a single motor vehicle accident involving a deer, 15km East on highway 16, near the Holmes River. There were no injuries, although the deer was a casualty.
