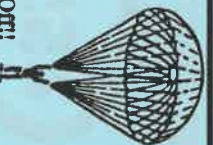

RECIPIENT OF B.G. SENIOR AWARD

Harrison Hot Springs senior John Willison Green, 73, has been selected as the recipient of the B.C. Senior Award for the year 2000. A Gold Medal, together with other prizes, has been presented annually to a worthy senior for the past 16 years. The Senior Award program was initiated by The Brock House Society to recognize a senior who has shown dedication to the service of the community and who has a demonstrated record of continuing community involvement. Nominations for this award are received from communities, associations and friends from throughout the province. The Award committee is always impressed with the dedication, skill and involvement displayed by all the nominees and it was difficult to choose a single winner.

John Green has used his imagination to promote objectives which will be appreciated by generations to come, in particular, his leadership in the development of the swimming lagoon and beach at Harrison Hot Springs and the preservation of the heritage Kilby General Store Museum at Harrison Mills. Other projects of his that have endured and flourished include his International Sand Sculpture Competition at Harrison Beach, and his study of the search for the Sasquatch. Harrison Hot Springs was a fortunate village when the Green family settled there many years ago. In his occupation as publisher and journalist supporting a family, he has discreetly furthered local social goals rather than achieve personal financial success or business recognition. 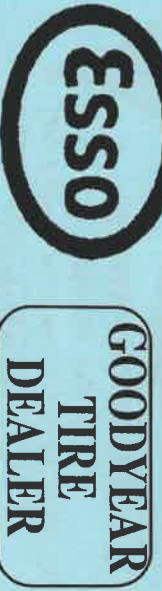
