

#### POLICE REPORT

On October 21, there was a motor vehicle accident on Highway 16 just west of McBride when a local resident struck a deer. There were no injuries and the deer fled into the bush.

Also on the 21, a local resident was stopped for speeding and was also found to be impaired by alcohol. Charges of impaired driving have been forwarded to crown. The driver also received a twenty four hour driving suspension and was served with notice of the mandatory 90 day suspension from the superintendent of motor vehicles.

On the 24 there was a suspicious person reported at the Travellers Restaurant. The individual was identified and spoken to.

On October 25 a pedal bike was found and turned into the RCMP. The owner may claim by identifying same.

On the 26, of October, a red Cruise Vest was reported lost around the Small River area, this vest is used for work and contains some valuable items, if anyone has any information as to the whereabouts of this vest, please contact the RCMP.

On the 26 of October McBride RCMP responded to a complaint of break enter and theft at a residence on 5th Ave. The B&E occurred sometime during the 21st and 22nd of October. Alcohol and cash were taken. Anyone having any information regards to this offence is asked to contact the McBride RCMP.

Recently our community has seen the introduction of video lottery terminals. These devices are not licensed by the Lottery Corporation and are intended for entertainment only just like other video arcade games. When these devices are used as a form of gambling where a pay out of any type is offered they become illegal. (We money, prizes, drinks etc.)

Any business operating these VLT's illegally is committing a criminal offence of running what is called a gaming or betting house.

Also any person participating in the playing of illegal VLT's is in contravention of the Criminal Code and can be charged for being in a common gaming or betting house.

No criminal charges have been laid at this time however the business has been advised of the law and given the opportunity to rectify the situation on their own. We are also to educate the public who could unwittingly find themselves in an illegal situation.
