### EMPLOYEES BEWARE

Canada Customs & Revenue Agency (CCRA) has issued a bulletin to advise that they will be auditing gratuities.  
\*CCRA is encouraging all employers to notify their employees that tips are taxable and are to be reported on line 104 of their personal income tax return.  
\*Tip #1 - report your tips and gratuities. The Income Tax Act states that you are required by law to report all income including tips and gratuities on your income tax return.  
\*Tip #2 - penalties and re-assessments may apply if you do not report these earnings.  
\*Tip #3 - ask your employer to make additional tax deductions to cover these tip to avoid paying a larger tax bill at the end of the year.  
\*Tip #4 - CCRA allows you to make quarterly instalments.  
\*Tip #5 - there will be no tax penalties if you voluntarily disclose and provide complete information on previously unreported income, however you will be required to pay taxes owing plus interest.  
\*Tip #6 - earnings from tips and gratuities can be included for Canada Pension Plan purposes and for RRSP purposes.  
\*Tip #7 - Keeping a record of tips and gratuities during the year will make year end easier.

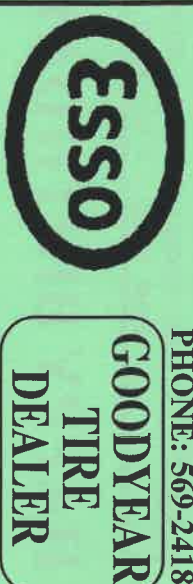
